

EU Gateway to Korea back in business for the next 5 years

European Union to continue successful business collaboration initiative in Korea

[EU Gateway | Business Avenues](#) is a flagship programme of the EU helping European companies to establish **long-lasting business collaborations in Asia** through **matchmaking and business services**. Between 2008 and 2014, 435 European companies participated to more than 6,400 individual business meetings over 15 missions to Korea, and two-thirds of previous participants reported **positive business collaboration results after one year**.

Following the first successful edition, **EU Gateway to Korea is back** to offer **selected European companies** the opportunity to participate in a [business mission](#). The initiative has also expanded and it is now covering two new [sectors](#), for a total of five competitive industries:

- Environment & Water Technologies
- Green Energy Technologies
- Construction & Building Technologies
- Healthcare & Medical Technologies
- Food & Beverages (Organic only)

EU Gateway to Korea provides coaching, logistical and financial support for European companies targeting [Korea](#). A **dedicated team in Europe as well as in the local market** ensures a **unique set of services** to:

- sound out **business opportunities in Korea**
- **minimise the costs** typically required to enter a new market
- benefit from **professional coaching and follow-up** at all stages
